Wings of Desire

In these tough economic times, it's nice to find good food at reasonable prices. Best Wingers is a terrific little joint in the heart of Murray Hill that has excellent Buffalo wings and much more.

As much as I would love to have oysters for lunch everyday, it gets expensive, so I stepped into Best Wingers on a recent afternoon and both my stomach and pockets left full. They have terrific combination specials and you get generous portions. I had six wings with a can of soda and a side dish for only \$6.99. Plus, they gave me a baker's half dozen – seven wings (they must have known who I was).

Sides include macaroni salad, potato salad, coleslaw, rice and beans, corn on cob, macaroni and cheese, and several other options. I went for the mac and cheese – a half pound, which was good – not the best I have ever had, it needed some more salt, but it was good. The wings were perfectly cooked – spicy but not killer, served with the usual bleu cheese dressing and celery sticks. (And they give you ample moist towelettes for the necessary cleanup afterwards.)

The place is tiny and really more of a takeout restaurant, but they have three small tables and a little side area, so there is usually a place to park yourself. The menu is quite large and includes gyros, chicken sandwiches, fried chicken, fish and chips, fried shrimp, salads, ribs, and burgers.

For a quick, nourishing bite that won't leave just feathers in your wallet, try Best Wingers.
