This place is an awful lot of fun. A cowboy – er, cowgirl – themed restaurant that boasts excellent southwestern/Tex-Mex food and awesome cocktails.

Start out with any of their flavored frozen margaritas, served in a mason jar. For a main course, choose between fajitas, ribs, po' boys, Jack Daniel's glazed pork chops or, my absolute favorite here, chicken fried steak, done in the classic style with white gravy, creamy mashed potatoes, and vegetables. Hearty and delicious!

I am not big on desserts, but I must make an exception here for Cowgirl's Original Ice Cream Baked Potato, the cleverest dessert I can easily recall, and perfect for sharing. A mound of vanilla ice cream is formed into the shape of a potato, dusted with cocoa powder, then topped with a dollop of whipped cream resembling butter and green sprinkles for chives, along with hot fudge and chopped pecans. Its cuteness is only matched by its deliciousness.

So take off your ten-gallon hat and put your six-shooters down – this is a solid bet for a good time.
